April 2010 Meeting Minutes

President Mike Wright called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Lynne Mayer led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mike thanked Linda Flanagan and all the helpers for the St. Patrick's Day Block Party. Thanks to Linda Silcox for the entrance decorations.

Secretary's Report: March meeting minutes were approved as posted on the website. Secretary Fran Gawlinski advised that the minutes would also be e-mailed to everyone who has an e-mail, and hand delivered to those who don't.

Treasurer's Report: Beginning balance was \$2646.10. Deposit of \$93 for various 50/50. Deposit payment for 2 tickets to the Romance Cruise \$165. Payment to Romance Cruise-2nd deposit \$822.00, Dan Mierswa for Feb. Chocolate Party 48.44, Jackie Mierswa for Sunshine cards & stamps. New balance \$2021.65. Minutes were approved.

Committee Reports:

Sunshine Committee: No Report, Jackie Mierswa wasn't present.

Welcome Committee: No report.

April Luncheon Cruise is set for Wednesday April, 14th from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. 49 people have signed up for the cruise. There is 1 ticket left. Final payment is due on Monday, April 5th.

Frisbee Golf is scheduled for May at the Manor. It will be on the same night as the meeting. It will start at 4:30 pm, because we can't get into the Manor until 4pm because of bingo. So there will be a social ½ hour at 4:30pm, the regular meeting, and then food (subs & sides, BYOB) & Frisbee Golf starting at about 5:30 pm. Cost would be \$5 per person.

Maggi Phillips made a suggestion that the cost of the food would come out of the Treasury. It was approved unanimously.

Mike Wright explained the concept of Frisbee Golf. It's a hula hoop on a post and you have to throw a Frisbee through the hula hoop. It won't be as long as it is for the Olympics. It will be on the east side of the Manor in the shade.

June Bowling Day is scheduled for Wednesday, June 30. \$10 for 2 hours of bowling, including shoes. Sign-up sheet at desk. There will be gutter rails for people who really can't bowl. All you have to do is roll it; you don't have to swing it. There is even a ramp to make it easier.

September -- Brunch. We have a chairperson for that. Will discuss further as time goes on.

New Business:

Mike & Linda went to a meeting with the Plantation dance committee. All dances already have host villages, except July 2010 and a couple in 2011. We should decide if we want to host a dance. The decorations are

supplied, unless you wish to buy anything and the Plantation reimburses for that, you by and put out the snacks, which the Plantation reimburses for, and you get the half of the 50/50 not going to the winner.

Nominating Committee:
