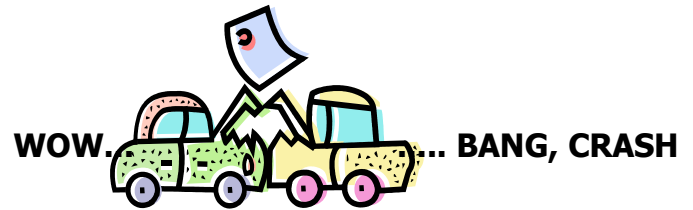
NEWSWORTHY RE: PLANTATION PLAZA
