GARY SALZMAN ACCEPTS PRESIDENTIAL AWARD FOR P.E.A.R. PARK VOLUNTEERS



As President of the P.E.A.R. Association, Gary proudly accepted the **President's Volunteer Service award** on behalf of over 150 volunteers who gave their time to improve the park. The 10,675 certified service hours put in by the volunteers earned them gold status-the highest level of award. Most of their hours were spent restoring the 50 acres of grasslands into a Florida scrub jay habitat. Their thousands of hours were spent planting and tending thousands of trees and shrubs as well as gardens, trails, flowerbeds, a grape arbor, and creating a nature center.



The association received a framed certificate of the award along with a congratulatory letter signed by former President George W. Bush, at a County Commission meeting this spring. An article praising the volunteers' efforts and telling of their achievements appeared in the May 14th Lake County section of the Orlando Sentinel. Congratulations to Gary and all!
